THE MASS

<u>The Mass is the Memorial of the Holy Sacrifice of Christ on the Cross.</u> The Mass is the Real Presence of Jesus. The Mass is the Holy Communion with the Lord.

MASS MAKES PRESENT THE SACRIFICE OF THE CROSS

Mass involves the real sacrifice of Jesus Christ, the Son of God, who in his death offered His life as a total gift to the Father and redeemed the world. In the Mass this sacrifice of the Lord on the cross is present to us in an unbloody manner. "The sacrifice of Christ and the sacrifice of the Eucharist are one single sacrifice." (CCC 1367)

"DO THIS IN REMEMBRANCE OF ME" (I CORINTHIAN 11:24-25)

At the Last Supper when Jesus said that His body would be offered up and His blood poured out (Matthew 26:26-28), he was already anticipating (was making sacramentally present) His sacrifice on the cross. So the body and blood Jesus gave at the last supper is the body and blood that was sacrificed on Calvary and this is what made present to us in the Mass by the words of Christ and power off the Holy Spirit (CCC 1357). So Mass is the memorial. It is not a mere recalling a past event, but it makes that event present (CCC 1363). It is the memory perpetuated until the end of the world. (CCC 1366)
