THE MASS (HOLY EUCHARIST) IS THE REAL PRESENCE OF JESUS

Christ is present in many ways; in the poor, in His Word, in the Sacraments, in prayer, etc. But He is uniquely present in the Eucharist (CCC 1374). He is entirely present - Body, Soul and Divinity of Christ. It is not a mere symbol; not just spiritually present in bread and wine. Remember the words of Jesus at the Last Supper; This is my body and this is my blood.

When the priest recites these words of Jesus at the time of consecration, Bread and Wine on the altar are changed into Body and Blood of Christ. It is not a chemical change. The bread still tastes and looks like bread, and the wine still tastes and looks like wine. But underneath of these appearances, it is truly Jesus' Body and Blood (CCC 1376).

It is Jesus' own words, not only at the Last Supper. He taught about His flesh and blood as true food and true drink. "He who eats my flesh and drinks my blood abides in me, and I in him." (John 6:53-56). As Christians, we trust in Jesus' words about the Eucharist really being His body and blood. "Do not see in the bread and wine merely as natural elements, because the Lord has expressly said that they are His body and His blood. Faith assures you of this, those your senses suggest otherwise."- St. Cyril of Jerusalem

Emmanuel: One of the biblical titles for Jesus means God with us (Matthew 1:23). Jesus is with us and He desires to remain close to us so He gave us the gift of His sacramental presence in the Eucharist. During every Mass, Son of God himself comes upon our altars and dwells in our midst. His presence continues to abide in the Eucharist reserved in the Tabernacle. We should reverence the presence of Christ in the Eucharist through holy gestures of genuflection, profound bow, etc. We make adoration of the Blessed Sacrament (Holy Eucharist)
