THE LITURGY

The word "liturgy" means "public work or service" on behalf of people. In our Christian tradition it means the participation of people of God in "the work of God." In a closer look we see that it is the work of God done in Christ for His people: the Redemption. Christ continues the redemptive work, which he accomplished on his cross and resurrection, in, with, and through the Church

ACTION OF THE CHURCH- (CCC 1071-72)

Because Christ continues Hi work of redemption in His Church, it is also an action of the Church(1071). This act makes the Church the visible sign of our communion in Christ, that we get in to communion with God and with one another in Christ.

THE LITURGY MAKES PRESENT THE SAVING EVENT (CCC 1104)

The liturgy not only recalls the paschal mysteries of (the passion, death and resurrection) of Christ, which saved us, but actualizes them and makes them present by the Holy Spirit. In the liturgy the paschal mysteries of Christ, is celebrated, not repeated. The pasta mystery of Christ is a unique historical event. Even though it is historical, it cannot remain only in the past. Because all that Christ is and all that he did pass through the ages until the end of time. The event of Cross and resurrection abides and draws everything toward life(CCC 1085).

CHURCH IS THE PROPER PLACE (CCC 2691)

The church, house of God is the proper place for the liturgical prayer of the parish community. It is the privileged place of worship and adoration of the real presence of Christ in the Blessed Sacrament. A church, is a house of prayer in which the Eucharist is celebrated and reserved, where the faithful assemble to worship Him.

RESPONSE OF FAITH (CCC 1083)

In the liturgy we are called to have faith in and love for the spiritual blessings the Father bestows upon us in Christ. So, before we come to participate in the liturgy we are called to faith and to conversion (Sacrosanct Concilium 9)
